

GNOSALL PARISH COUNCIL DRAFT Grant Awarding Policy



Gnosall Parish Council, each year, reserves an amount of money for the disbursement of grants to organisations within the parish of Gnosall.

An award of a grant must give direct benefit to all or some of the inhabitants of the parish

Applications will only be considered when made using a formal application form requested from the Clerk.

The organisation requesting a grant will be asked to:

- a) Describe the role of the organisation and the work it undertakes for the benefit of the inhabitants of the parish of Gnosall
- b) Provide a copy of the latest set of accounts (preferably audited)
- c) Give full details of the purpose for which the grant is required, with financial details of the proposed scheme and/or funding requirement and whether funding from other sources is being requested.

Organisations which receives a grant of £500 or more will be required to submit financial details showing how the grant has been used

The Parish Council will give priority to organisations that are fund raising for projects which progress one or more of its corporate objectives.
